Arrangements of **Guided Tours**

: Guided Tour 1

Docents will be assigned by the HKCR to provide guided tour services for schools, leading participants to visit various places in the Stadium including its floors, player changing rooms and the gateway to the Stadium

The quotas for Guided Tour 1 are 220, with 22 for each school (including 2 teachers-in-charge).

Guided Tour 2

Docents will be assigned by the HKCR to provide guided tour services for schools, introducing to participants the rules of rugby sevens and its commonly used jargon.

Transport Arrangements : Schools must make their own transport arrangements to and from the Hong Kong Stadium. Schools arranging for students to travel on a coach must apply for a "Vehicle Drop-off Permit" (only for pick-up and drop-off of participants on coaches) to the Organiser via the LCSD.

"Vehicle Drop-off Permits" will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.

Drop-off points, as well as arrival and departure times will be specified by the Organiser during the event. Details will be announced in due course.
