In this context due regard should be paid to IEC 60825-1:2001 relating to requirements for radiation safety of laser products and equipment classification. Sufficient information and warning signs should be placed on the instruction manual or the laser product or its package.

I understand that to display of above effect on stage requires a risk assignment form and approved by the venue manager before presenting the laser effect on the stage.
